



PARENT AND SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP COMMITMENT FORM

We believe that raising a child is the most important task given to any parent. We commend you for seeking to provide a Christian education for your child, and our desire is to support you in this goal. A Christian education in today's cultural climate is no small task. It requires a great deal of sacrifice on the part of faculty, students, and parents. In light of our desire to provide the very best educational opportunity for each student, we ask our parents to agree to the following necessary commitments.

We commit to the following:

1. To support the development of a biblical worldview and academic excellence at River City Believers Academy by being actively involved with our child(ren)'s education.
2. To support the school's policies and procedures. We understand that attending the school is a privilege that may be withdrawn upon sufficient cause as determined by the administration.
3. To commit a minimum of 15 hours per semester per family to school affairs, functions and service for the purpose of providing support to the faculty, staff, and students.
4. To actively support the fundraising activities of the school with the realization that tuition alone does not cover the cost of educating my child(ren).
5. To be proactive in dealing with issues of academic, moral, spiritual and social growth of our child(ren) at the school. If a problem or concern should arise, we will take our concern directly to the person involved, in keeping with the Matthew 18 principle.
6. To not hold the school liable for any reason and that we will use sound biblical principles to settle any disputes.
7. To meet all financial obligations on a timely basis and follow the tuition payment guidelines as stated in the River City Believers Academy Financial Commitment Form and set forth by the RCBA school board. We agree to pay the remaining balance of our account before requesting transcripts to be released.
8. To attend a parent orientation and the scheduled parent meetings to learn about the school's philosophy of Christian education and the partnership between the school, church, and parents. (Parent orientation is a requirement for enrollment.)
